The village signs were originally erected to mark the Millennium and were partly funded by public subscription. The general recollection is that the Parish Council funded c.25%-30% of the project. In 2012 one of the posts failed, leading to the decorative sign being damaged. Major maintenance was undertaken and substantive concrete fixings installed. The estimated original cost of the "donated" / "adopted" signs has been set at £2100 and the insurance cost reflects the current estimated replacement cost of the signs and posts.

The Village signs were renovated in May 2023: Labour & parts were by donation from the group undertaking the repairs.
